# St. John's Weekly Financial Update

The present trend shows a deficit of \$57,000 by year end. \$35,000 of that was a deficit approved at the AGM last March; the other \$22,000 is the projected shortfall in offerings. Last week the PAR (preauthorized electronic giving) was not included. Although still significant, the shortfall is somewhat less than reported last week. Going forward we need offerings of at least \$3,600 per week to stay within the approved deficit.

Currently offerings average about \$2,800 per week.
