- St. John's has again been warned by the City of White Rock regarding unnecessary police response to false security alarms at the church. So, it behooves us to ensure that the church is fully secured and alarmed when we leave.
- The church security alarm monitoring firm has requested additional names on the emergency call-out list to respond when the alarm is activated after hours. Please speak to the Minister or the Clerk of Session if you would be willing to be on the call-out list.
