

Monday Reflection - “Waiting Before the Wind”

Scripture

“They were all together in one place.” Acts 2:1

Reflection

Before the rushing wind and tongues of fire, there was waiting.

The disciples did not know exactly when or how God would move, but they remained together in prayer and expectation.

Many of us struggle with waiting because waiting feels unproductive. Yet some of God’s deepest work happens in seasons when nothing seems to be changing.

Perhaps you are waiting today:

- for healing,
- for direction,
- for reconciliation,
- for strength,
- or for hope.

Pentecost reminds us that waiting is not wasted when it is placed in God’s hands.

Questions for Reflection

- What area of my life currently feels like a season of waiting?
- How can I remain spiritually attentive instead of discouraged?
- What does trusting God look like this week?

Action Step

Take 10 quiet minutes today simply to sit before God without rushing. Pray:

“Come, Holy Spirit.”
